



SCHIP Regulations

Broadspire January, 2012 Update MMSEA Section 111 (SCHIP)

On January 1, 2012, the Center for Medicare/Medicaid Services (CMS) in conjunction with the Coordination of Benefits Contractor (COBC) began emailing notifications to Responsible Reporting Entities (RRE's) containing an Annual Profile Report. The notice was to confirm the accuracy of company information, authorized representative, account manager and submission agent.

The COBC states, "If all information within the attached Profile Report is still accurate, a call or email to your EDI Representative will suffice to confirm and recertify your account information. If the Profile Report contains any inaccuracies or outdated information then you must contact your EDI Representative in order to provide them with the appropriate updates. After you have provided your EDI Representative with your updated information a new Profile Report will be transmitted to you via email. The Authorized Representative will then be required to sign and return the updated copy".

They further state, "... If the Authorized Representative has not responded to the annual profile report email within 30 days of receipt, they shall receive a non-receipt email. Failure to confirm this information may result in deactivation of the RRE..."
